D.O.C. Priorat — La Morera de Montsant

THE WINERY

The Pasanaus are perennial growers in La Morera, the highest municipality of Priorat, with vineyards at over 2,400 feet elevation abutting the sheer rock wall of the Sierra de Montsant. Gravelly scree eroded from the cliffs covers the underlying llicorella slate, together with the elevation creating a less Mediterranean microclimate relative to the region as a whole.

THE WINE

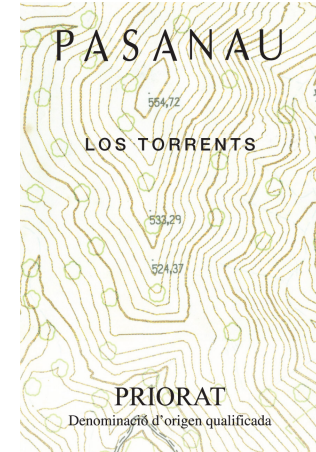
From two tiny parcels over 500 meters in elevation on exposed slate (llicorella) facing each other across a steep ravine. The north face is planted to Cariñena, the south to Garnacha. The 50/50 field blend is aged two years in French oak. Intense and powerful style retains fresh fruit character. 2400 bottles produced in February of 2016.

IN THE PRESS

Spicy notes of cinnamon, cardamom and vanilla frame black cherry and plum flavors in this generous red. Firm tannins are balanced by balsamic acidity. Licorice and cola details emerge on the finish, accented by a touch of heat. Drink now through 2022.
