## La Florens Garnacha 2014 - 6x750

### THE WINERY

Founded in the early 2000s by Josep Grau upon a base of Garnacha and Mazuelo (Carignan) vines between 40 and 100 years of age in the traditional Priorat villages of Marçà, Capçanes and Falset. Llicorella, chalk and clay terroirs exist side by side, allowing for subtle interplay between boldness and minerality. Maximum attention is paid to minimization of oak influence.

### THE WINE

100% Garnacha from a single plot over 100 years old, with predominating chalky-clay soils. Finesse and minerality are the objectives, the wine being aged one year in one 2000-liter Stockinger oval of Austrian oak. Stockinger uniquely retains freshness and fruit while developing layered complexity in the wine. Elegant. 2600 bottles produced.
