## Terrer d' Aubert 2011

*Vinyes del Terrer*

Vila-Seca — D.O. Tarragona

### THE WINERY

The Morell family vineyard estate is comprised of nine parcels totaling seventeen acres in the outskirts of Tarragona on the Spain's Mediterranean coast. Defying urban sprawl, the vineyards lie within a mile and half of the sea, their soils composed of calcareous loam derived from shell (fossil) limestone, known locally as *lumaquela*.

### THE WINE

Terrer d'Aubert is composed primarily of Cabernet Sauvignon and expresses the saline minerality of the sea breeze and limestone, with a long and gripping finish reminiscent of the great wines from Bordeaux's seaward communes of Pauillac and Saint-Estèphe. 15,000 bottles produced.

### DETAILS OF WINEMAKING & VITICULTURE

**Grapes:** 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

**Vineyards:** 17 acres near Mediterranean coast. Unique '*lumaquela*' soils composed of calcareous loam.

**Winemaking:** 12 months in seasoned French oak, barrels and 5000 liter uprights.

**Alcohol:** 13.5%



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
