THE WINE:

This incredibly old, dry Amontillado comes from the original solera acquired in 1822 by D. León de Argüeso y Argüeso upon founding the legendary firm that bears his name. Minuscule quantities are bottled each year from the three remaining casks. It expresses the maritime essence of Sanlúcar de Barrameda's Barrio Bajo district.

THE WINERY:

Historic firm founded in 1822 by Don León de Argüeso y Argüeso and bestowed upon his passing to nephew Juan and niece Francisca ("los Herederos"). Original soleras were acquired with 250-year-old Bodega San Carlos on Calle Santo Domingo in Sanlúcar's Barrio Bajo district.
